CURBSIDE PICKUP - Beginning June 22, you will be able to request and pick up Nanuet Public Library materials only. Interlibrary loan is not available at this time.

To request materials owned by Nanuet Public Library, call our main number at 845-623-4281. Nanuet cardholders can also place a hold through our online catalog. Download the RCLS Gateway app for easy access to the library catalog with your smartphone or tablet.

If you call to request materials, you will be given a date and time slot for pickup.

If you request materials through the catalog, wait for a phone call from the library to confirm that your materials are ready. You will be given a date and time slot for pickup.

When you arrive for pickup, call our main number at 845-623-4281 to let us know you're here. A library staff member, wearing appropriate PPE, will bring your materials out to your car. Please show your library card or ID through your car window so we can confirm the materials are going to the right person.

Please follow appropriate health and safety guidelines by wearing a cloth face covering when you come to the library. See below for further details on CDC guidelines for community health and safety practices.

RETURNING MATERIALS currently checked out -

The return drop will reopen on Monday, June 15. All physical materials currently checked out have a due date of June 30. Overdue fines on library materials will be waived

until further notice. Materials will be placed in quarantine for up to 7 days before being checked in. Materials must be returned via the return drop. Staff members cannot accept returns at curbside.

From The Director



To the Nanuet Community,

As the Mid-Hudson Valley region reopens, our staff is eager to return to the library. We miss you, and we sincerely appreciate your flexibility as we adjust our processes to serve you safely. Below is helpful guidance from the CDC. Please follow these guidelines when you come for curbside pickup. We must all do our part to keep each other safe.

GUIDANCE FROM CDC.GOV/CORONAVIRUS -

CDC has recommended the following measures to prevent the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. In the context of community transmission, CDC recommends that you:

Practice social distancing whenever possible (remaining at least 6 feet away from others).

Clean your hands often.

Wear a mask.

CDC recommends that everyone wear cloth face coverings when leaving their homes, regardless of whether they have fever or symptoms of COVID-19. This is because of evidence that people with COVID-19 can spread the disease, even when they don't have any symptoms. Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.

Is Summer Reading Club still happening?



Nanuet Public Library is pleased to welcome our new Librarian, Bob Boyle. Bob has spent most of his Librarian days across the river at The Field Library of Peekskill, part of Westchester Library System.

His library career began after realizing his undergraduate Philosophy degree was of little interest to the working world. Bob thought back to the friendly and inspiring librarians he worked for as a teenager at the Newburgh Free Library and went on to attend the University at Albany to get his Master of Library Science. He started working



part-time at The Field Library in 1997 before being hired there full-time as their Reference Librarian / Local History Specialist, getting an opportunity to assist researchers both locally and from all over the country in accessing its amazing Colin T. Naylor, Jr. Local History Archives, featuring books, photographs, genealogical materials, and maps going back to the late 1700's.

While Bob's job responsibilities at The Field Library evolved over the years and included positions as Head of Reference and Assistant Director, the basic work of what drew him to this profession, and what he enjoys most about it, has never changed—helping people. "You never know what to expect at the reference desk—computer instruction, resumé and job search assistance, finding the score to a piece of music...to be asked to find a German-language academic article and then the next person wants to reserve the latest season of a TV show— that's what keeps the job interesting," he says.

In his free time, Bob enjoys stand up paddle boarding, listening to all kinds of music, getting out in the woods for a hike, playing piano and learning guitar.

Bob is very happy to be joining the staff of Nanuet Public Library and to be working in RCLS, the same library system where his journey began. He looks forward to meeting and helping you soon!
